## Birding 3 Key Islands in Hawaii: Oahu, Kauai and Big Island October 12-20, 2021



- Oct 12:** Arrivals into Honolulu and then off to Waikiki
- Oct 13:** Birding the rainforests of the Koolau Mountains and Oahu endemic birding.
- Oct 14:** Oahu Island's North Shore and more
- Oct 15:** AM flight to Kauai and birding in different locations
- Oct 16:** Morning Hike through Kokee State Park; afternoon birding and sightseeing along Kauai's Coasts.
- Oct 17:** AM more Kauai birding and late PM arrival on Big Island.
- Oct 18:** Big Island Birding: Sub-Alpine Dry Forest of Mauna Kea, Mauna Loa and More
- Oct 19:** Birding Hakalau Forest NWR or alternative for endemics
- Oct 20:** Final Birding and fly out at mid-day or consider an extension to Volcano National Park

**Key Bird Species:** Hawaiian Goose, Hawaiian Duck, Hawaiian Coot, Pacific Golden-Plover, Bristle-thighed Curlew, Brown Noddy, Black Noddy, White Tern, White-tailed Tropicbird, Red-tailed Tropicbird, Laysan Albatross, Wedge-tailed Shearwater, Great Frigatebird, Brown Booby, Red-footed Booby, Hawaiian Hawk, Hawaii Elepaio, Kauai Elepaio, Oahu Elepaio, Omao, Palila, Apapane, Iiwi, Akiapolaau, Anianiau, Hawaii Amakihi, Oahu Amakihi, Kauai Amakihi, Hawaii Creeper, and Hawaii Akepa. Plus numerous introduced species including Erckel's Francolin, Red Junglefowl, White-rumped Shama, Zebra Dove, Rose-ringed Parakeet, Red-crested Cardinal, Saffron Finch, Warbling White-eye, Red Avadavat, and more.

**Other Wildlife:** Humpback Whale, Hawaiian Monk Seal, Spinner Dolphin, Spotted Dolphin, Short-finned Pilot Whale, Hawaiian Green Sea Turtle, Mongoose
