



Cool Summer Break: Pacific Northwest Birding June 20-28, 2021



- June 20:** Arrival into Portland by Noon. Afternoon Birding Sauvie Island to Longview.
- June 21:** Oregon Coastal Birding; Fort Stevens State Park along coast to Newport.
- June 22:** Birding from Newport to Florence with stops at many hotspots, including Sea lion Caves.
- June 23:** Oregon coastal birding AM, birding to Eugene PM
- June 24:** Birding McKenzie Pass and forests on way to Bend.
- June 25 & 26:** Birding mountains and trails around Bend.
- June 27:** AM in Bend, full afternoon birding up Mount Hood.
- June 28:** AM birding along Columbia River, Noon flights home

Key Bird Species: Anna’s Hummingbird, Allen’s Hummingbird, Pacific-slope Flycatcher, Dusky Flycatcher, Hammond’s Flycatcher, Hutton’s Vireo, Cassin’s Vireo, Violet-green Swallow, Chestnut-backed Chickadee, Bushtit, Pacific Wren, Wrentit, Pelagic Cormorant, Brandt’s Cormorant, Black Oystercatcher, Black Turnstone, Surfbird, Red-necked Phalarope, Common Murre, Pigeon Guillemot, Tufted Puffin, Rhinoceros Auklet, Western Gull, Glaucous-winged Gull, Heermann’s Gull, Sooty Shearwater, Band-tailed Pigeon, Northern Pygmy-Owl, Great Gray Owl, Black Swift, Vaux’s Swift, Sooty Grouse, Ruffed Grouse, Mountain Quail, Northern Goshawk, White-headed Woodpecker, Red-breasted Sapsucker, Williamson’s Sapsucker, Canada Jay, Clark’s Nutcracker, American Dipper and Varied Thrush. Warblers could include MacGillivray’s, Black-throated Gray, Townsend’s and Hermit.

Other Wildlife: California Sea Lions, Steller Sea Lions, Harbor Seals, and more wildlife.
